

CAREER OPPORTUNITY ARENA MAINTENANCE (OPERATOR)

The successful candidate will be responsible for the operation, maintenance, and repair of ice surfaces and arena equipment, as well as the upkeep of the facility to meet community standards.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- A valid Power Engineers Class 4 or Class 5 Refrigeration ticket is required.
- Valid Manitoba Driver's License, Class 5
- Verifiable Equipment Operating Experience
- Certification in facility maintenance, boiler ticket, pool operator, or pest control will be an asset.
- Completion of Grade 12 or related experience or qualifications will be considered.
- Proficient with various power tools and motorized grounds maintenance equipment
- Must be able and willing to perform all the duties of the job in all weather conditions.
- Effectively prioritize personal workload and work efficiently and in accordance with established procedures with minimal direct supervision.
- Good working knowledge of the workplace safety and health regulations
- Must relate courteously with the public and portray a positive public image.
- Willingness to work overtime
- Satisfactory criminal record and vulnerable persons checked by the RCMP

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Knowledge and effective application of the principles and procedures of ice making and maintenance of an artificial ice surface
- Safe and efficient operation and maintenance of a refrigeration plant and all components
- Operation of ice resurfacing machines, ventilation, and heating systems via building automation network controllers and all related equipment
- All building maintenance tasks, including custodian and other functions necessary to operate The Pas Recreation and Wellness Centre
- During off-season, complete tasks necessary for the maintenance of other facilities and all green space including but not limited to parks, playgrounds, ball diamonds, and other outdoor areas in the community.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
