This full-time position is responsible for variety of manual labor tasks to support the maintenance and repair of municipal infrastructure, including roads, sidewalks, water and sewer systems, parks, and other public facilities.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of Grade 12.
- Valid Manitoba Class 5 Driver's License (Class 3 is considered an asset).
- Skills and knowledge in carpentry, along with experience operating small maintenance equipment, hand tools, and power tools.
- Strong ability to work effectively in a team environment and independently with minimal supervision.
- Good communication and comprehension skills with the ability to maintain cooperative and productive working relationships.
- Good working knowledge of the Workplace Safety & Health Regulations.
- Ability to medically and physically perform demanding tasks such as lifting, bending, and walking for extended periods and overtime, as well as working in various weather conditions.
- Satisfactory criminal record and vulnerable persons checked by the RCMP.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Operate and maintain a variety of hand tools, power tools, and light equipment necessary for job duties.
- Perform routine maintenance, repair, and construction of municipal infrastructure, including roads, sidewalks, drainage systems, and public buildings.
- Assist in the maintenance and operation of water and sewer systems, including valve operation, hydrant flushing, and pipe repairs.
- Perform seasonal tasks such as snow removal, street sweeping, sanding, and salting of roads and sidewalks.
- Assist in the upkeep of municipal parks, playgrounds, and green spaces, including mowing, tree trimming, and landscaping.
- Follow safety protocols and always wear required personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Perform other duties as assigned.
